



CANINE INFLUENZA WAIVER

CANINE INFLUENZA IS A NEWLY EMERGING INFECTIOUS DISEASE CAUSED BY A "FLU" VIRUS. COMMON SIGNS OF THE CANINE FLU ARE: PERSISTANT COUGH (SOFT, MOIST, "PRODUCTIVE" COUGH OR DRY COUGH SIMILAR TO KENNEL COUGH), LOW-GRADE FEVER, NASAL DISCHARGE, LACK OF ENERGY, AND LOSS OF APPETITE.

RAE-ZOR GBD IS STAYING WELL EDUCATED AND CONSULTING THE OPINIONS OF TRUSTED VETERINARIANS REGARDING THE CANINE INFLUENZA VIRUS AS WELL AS THE H3N8 VACCINE; ONLY SOME ARE MAKING IT A STANDARD REQUIREMENT. IF A PET HAS CONTRACTED THE CANINE FLU VIRUS, SYMPTOMS AND TREATMENTS ARE SIMILAR TO THE SYMPTOMS AND TREATMENT OF KENNEL COUGH.

RAE-ZOR GBD WILL LEAVE THE DECISION TO VACCINATE YOUR PET WITH THE CANINE INFLUENZA VACCINATION (H3N8) TO THE OWNER AND THE VET OF YOUR CHOOSING TO CONSULT. RAE-ZOR GBD IS NOT MAKING THE CANINE INFLUENZA VACCINE A STANDARD REQUIREMENT FOR OUR GUESTS AT THIS TIME. THE LIABILITY LIES SOLEY WITH THE OWNER IF HE/SHE CHOOSES TO RENDER THE SERVICES OF OUR FACILITY WITH OR WITHOUT RECEIVING THE CANINE INFLUENZA VACCINE.

RAE-ZOR GBD IS RESERVING THE RIGHT TO AMEND THE REQUIREMENTS OF ALL PETS TO INCLUDE THE CANINE INFLUENZA (H3N8) VACCINE IN THE NECESSARY VACCINES REQUIRED TO RENDER THE SERVICES OF OUR FACILITY.
